


Resources and under that is the *Library*. The books are listed by name and by author with a brief synopsis.



Where Does Dedicating a Child Come From?

As a child Jesus was brought by Joseph and Mary to the house of the Lord. This was an act of dedication and recognition that He belonged to God. People brought children to Jesus throughout His ministry. He placed His hands on them and blessed them. As Christians, we recognize that everything we have belongs to God, including our children.

What Are the Prerequisites of Dedicating My Child?

The Parent-Baby Dedication is more than a ritual. It is a commitment on the part of the parents to honor the will of God and the Word of God.

The Parent-Baby Dedication is designed for Christian parents who are faithfully involved and growing as a part of the Sunnyside family.

What Does Dedicating a Child Mean?

Dedication is not the salvation of a child, but a public expression that he or she belongs to God. This "setting apart" is an act by the parents—a prayerful declaration of their stewardship to God. The parents are seeking to do every-thing that is in their power, as God gives them wisdom, to see that their child grows up to accept and honor God.

As a Part of This Dedication, You As Parents Are:

- 1. Publicly affirming your personal faith in Christ and your dedication to Him and His Word.
- 2. Dedicating yourselves to pray daily for God's direction in your lives and in the lives of your children.
- 3. Dedicating yourselves to faithfully engage in regular worship services with your children.
- 4. Dedicating yourselves to teach your children the truths of God's Word in your home.

5. Recognizing that your children belong to God and that your children have been born to experience His love and to serve Him.
